Keweenaw Green Burial Alliance Goal Policy 01: Membership Development

Date Adopted: November 29, 2017

The Keweenaw Green Burial Alliance (KGBA) hereby adopts the following membership policy to establish a general membership for the organization and to specify all criteria, benefits, and responsibilities of membership.

As specified in our bylaws, our membership structure must establish at minimum the following items:

- 1. Membership qualifications, if any
- 2. Membership dues and responsibilities, if any
- 3. Membership privileges and benefits, if any
- 4. Membership voting privileges, if any

Those items are specified below, followed by additional membership criteria.

1. Membership Qualifications

• Members shall demonstrate good faith support for green/natural burial practices and the activities of the Alliance.

2. Membership Dues and Responsibilities

- No dues are required for membership.
- Members shall confirm their membership and contact information periodically upon request (no more than once per year).

3. Membership Privileges and Benefits

- A stronger Alliance to support and advocate for local green/natural burial options.
- A voice in the work of the Alliance, including input toward KGBA positions on how green/natural burial options might be best defined for our local community.
- Opportunities for networking with other members for help with burial planning, actual burials, and related concerns or projects.
- The right to full participation on Board committees.
- The right to attend Board of Directors business meetings (including, with two weeks prior notice, the right to request an agenda slot to address the Board or make a presentation).
- Email updates on local green burial developments.
- Access to all benefits also provided to the general public, such as periodic membership programs, web resources, and general assistance.

Membership Voting Privileges

• At this time, members are not granted voting rights within the organization. However, members who are serving on a Board Committee do have the right to vote on committee business, subject to how that committee determines its own decision making process.

5. Revocation of Membership

- Should the Board of Directors determine that a member has failed to demonstrate good faith support for green/natural burial practices and/or the activities of the Alliance, his/her membership may be revoked by a majority vote of the Board.
- Should any member fail to confirm his/her intention to continue membership after a reasonable number of contact attempts, he/she may be removed from the membership roll.

6. Additional Criteria

- All members of the Board of Directors must maintain active membership.
- All members serving on a Board Committee must maintain active membership.
